
Club Highlights

Annual Member Meeting Report

Chair Ashburn called the meeting to order at 5:06p.m. and welcomed the members to the Annual Meeting.

<u>Finance</u>: Ed reported that the Club's financial position during 2012 remained steady. We ended the year with cash assets on hand of \$253.385, which was an increase of \$6,501. Performance thus far in 2013 is comparable to this time in 2012. The 2013 Board-approved budget estimates a reduction of assets by approximately \$1,000, however estimates of income were conservative. The principal remaining on our campus loan used to support the most recent expansion is \$150,000. The final payment is scheduled to be made by the end of 2015.

We continue to be in a strong financial position and have sufficient assets to support future programs for the benefit of the membership.

<u>House Committee</u>: The Campus Office of Design & Construction recently hired a consultants' group to survey campus facilities and the Faculty Club was included in that survey. The consultants' report indicated there are currently no major maintenance concerns; i.e. the building is in good shape. However they did propose some projects for the future.

Program Committee: Tom reported on the Committee's activities in the Manager's report. He summarized the many and varied activities of the past year including such events as the Spanish Wine Dinner, a Western BBQ, Eight Bells Winery dinner and the traditional Brunch with the Bunny and Easter Egg Hunt. Events upcoming in the remainder of 2013 include a dinner with Rex Pickett in conjunction with the opening of *Sideways* at the La Jolla Playhouse, an August 6 lunchtime acknowledgement of Cecil Green's birthday with cookies and Green sundaes, a beer tasting Oktoberfest on Oct. 18, a wine tasting in November again with Eight Bells Winery and the traditional holiday party on Dec. 15.

A highlight of the year will be the Faculty Club's 25th anniversary on Nov. 15 in conjunction with Founders' Weekend.

<u>Arts Subcommittee:</u> Alain reported on the committee's activities for 2013. A showing of Ansel Adams photographs from the UCSD archives will open in June and continue through the summer. During Fall Quarter through January 2014, Sylvia Bal Somerville will present a showing of her photography and Mimi Bates will have a showing of abstract paintings from February through May of 2014.

<u>Manager's report</u>: Tom reported that sales are ahead of last year for April which was the best month in years. Several large events contributed to this success including the Taste of the Triangle and a Memorial for Pat Hyndman. Also, the Chancellor is using the Club quite often. The Club provides a better value than area hotels. Due to the number of weddings and farewell parties coming up, May is looking very good.

Nominating Committee: Ed reported that there are seven Board members' terms ending. All currently-serving members agreed to be included on the ballot. The slate of candidates will be placed in nomination and forwarded to the membership immediately via a mail ballot. The Ballot will include: Community Members Penny Alexander and Sally Ashburn; Faculty Representatives Larry Armi, SIO, Lynn Russell, SIO and Ernie Belezzuoli, Radiology; Staff Representatives Lynda Claassen and Bob Starkey.


Chilled Avocado Soup Recipe
