In the past decade, San Diego has grown into a Craft Beer Mecca. There are currently 152 craft breweries in San Diego and there are more breweries slated to open in the coming months. We have an embarrassment of riches here in San Diego when it comes to beer. Every year our local breweries win local and national awards for quality and taste.

The Faculty Club needs your help. We currently have 6 beer taps in the Lounge, but only 3 taps are currently being utilized. We want to change that and we want our members' input in picking 6 new beers that will make up our new lineup.

During our Happy Hour on October 11th, we need you to turn out and help us pick our new Tap lineup. We want to serve you the freshest and tastiest local craft beers. We could have just picked the lineup ourselves, but where is the fun in that?

From 4:00pm to 7:00pm, we will have 6 breweries that will compete for your vote. For only \$10, you will get as many samples as you like and be able to pair those beers with some light appetizers. Each brewery will be bringing two beers that they feel best showcase their brand. You will be able to speak with the brewers or the brewery reps about the beer and the stories behind the beers.

Members that take part in this event will get a scorecard to let us know which beers they liked the most. The beers with the highest scores will be the beers that we end up putting on tap.

Once all the breweries that are competing are on board, we will send out an email flyer to let everyone know who will be taking part in the event and which beers that they will be serving.

We are really looking forward to seeing everyone at the Lounge on October 11th, 4:00pm to 7:00pm. Please be ready to sample some beer and have some fun!
