## APRIL 4 WINE DINNER WITH SYMBIOSIS WINERY

Join Club members for a five-course dinner featuring wines from a UCSD alumna's Paso Robles winery. On Saturday, April 4, Glenna Thompson of Symbiosis Wines will be on hand to discuss her wines and her winemaking. Glenna earned a Ph.D. in marine microbiology from Scripps Institution of Oceanography, but a wine tasting trip to the central coast lured her to Paso Robles, where she spent several years running labs for various wineries. Recognizing that winemaking was a symbiotic mix of art and science, she launched Symbiosis in 2007. Symbiosis is a "small and green" operation where grapes are hand harvested using sustainable practices and wines are made on site, by hand, by Glenna.

The menu for the April 4 dinner will feature 5 Symbiosis wines. Recipes for the paired dishes have been suggested by the winemaker and will be interpreted by Carmine Lopez, the Club's executive chef. (Her Valentine's Day dinner was superb!) The menu will be posted next week, but save the date!
