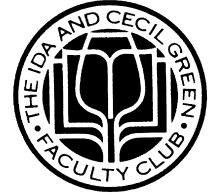


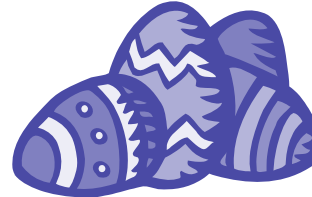

Greek Ambassador Visits the Club

On Thursday, February 1st, a reception and dinner took place honoring His Excellency Alexandros P. Mallias, Ambassador of Greece to the United States, and the Honorable Dimitris Caramitsos-Tziras, Consul General of Greece in Los Angeles. The evening also featured a percussion performance by UCSD Music Professor Steven Schick of Iannis Xenakis' "Rebonds".

The event was attended by members of the San Diego Greek-American community and Philhellenes. The dignitaries thanked the community members for their efforts and contributions toward establishing three Endowed Chairs in Greek History at UCSD and discussed the importance the Hellenic tradition has always attached to education. All three chairs—the Ranglas Chair in Ancient Greek History, the Vassiliadis Chair in Byzantine Greek History, and the Nicholas Chair in Modern Greek History—are now fully funded.

In 2008, American voters may have the chance to make history by electing the first African-American President. Some consider Senator Barack Obama the first viable African-American presidential candidate. Others don't think he is electable. Is race still an issue or is Obama simply not qualified?

Professor Zoltan Hajnal will discuss his research on voting behavior, including historical data from previous elections involving African-American candidates. His new book, *Changing White Attitudes toward Black Political Leadership*, addresses the question of whether white voters can change their minds about African-American candidates.
