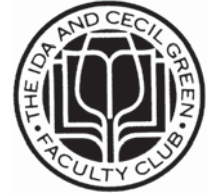

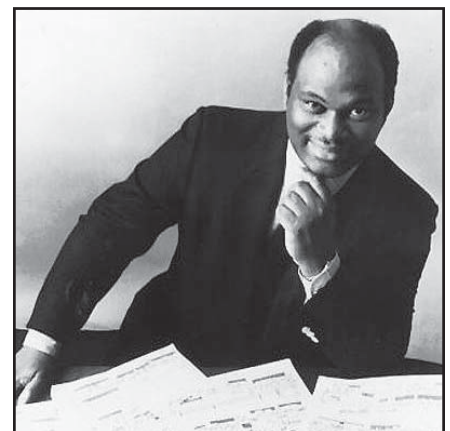

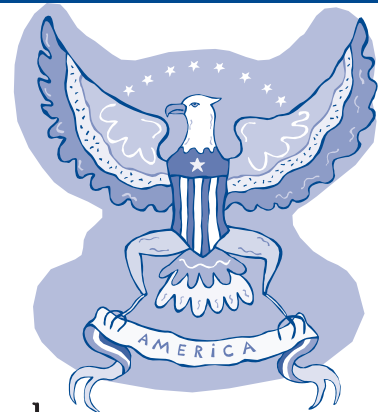

## Winter Art Exhibition: “Different Chapters” Viviana Lombrozo



“Different Chapters” was created over the past three years using a variety of mixed media techniques including painting, sewing, calligraphy, collage, and encaustic.

“The inspiration comes from two ongoing chapters of my own life: my role as an artist and as a language interpreter. As an interpreter, my medium is spoken communication. I transform one language into another, preserving the content. As an artist, my

medium is visual expression. I transform emotions and ideas into a visual language, revealing content and suggesting meaning. But the boundaries between translation and transformation are never rigid, and this body of work explores the dance between different modes of communication and different vehicles for expression. Letters, words, books, symbols, images, and visual abstraction combine seamlessly into a unified experience.”

The opening reception with the artist will take place on Thursday, January 8 from 4:00 to 6:00 pm.

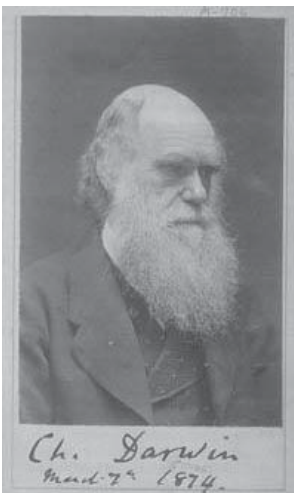
