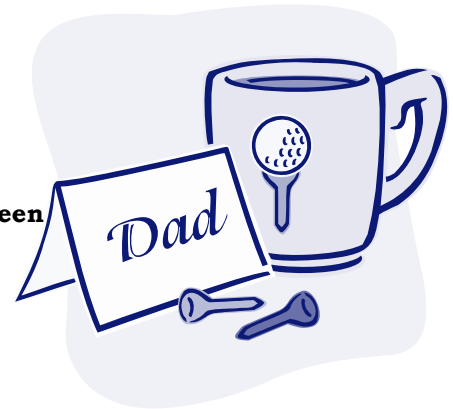

## Annual Meeting Report

**The annual meeting was held on Tuesday, May 15th and the following was discussed and reported.**

**Finance:** Ed Mayer distributed the Treasurer's report. He commented most favorably on the Club's financial outlook. Because of a very strong two months at the beginning of this year after the Club reopened, the Club is anticipating an excellent 2007. Revenues for the first quarter of 2007 have increased over 2006 by 29%. Ed also commented regarding the debt service incurred due to the Club's participation in the Capi-

tal Campaign, but he indicated the Club should have little difficulty meeting this commitment. The Club remains in an excellent financial position. This gives the Club the ability to make improvements not covered by the recent expansion and to support programs for the benefit of the Club membership.

**House Committee:** Gary Matthews presented the House Committee's report which focused on the recent expansion. The design has been extremely well received. A number of events have moved from other venues to the Atkinson Pavilion and this has become the "place to be". We've heard nothing but positive statements. Future considerations will include shade space in front of the pavilion. Doors and other minor issues have been taken care of and the kitchen is much superior to the previous facility. The construction was of the highest quality and club useage was not negatively impacted.

**Membership Committee:** Lynda Claassen presented the Membership Committee's report. Total membership has stayed relatively the same. Both local and non-local members of the Alumni Association will be approached in the Fall to bolster our current numbers.

**Program Committee:** Nolan Penn recapped the year's activities which included the traditional events such as the various wine dinners which have been very successful. Upcoming events for 2007 include a May 24 Author's Reception with Richard Atkinson, June 17 Father's Day, Hawaiian Tropics Evening on August 10, an Italian wine dinner in October and the April 12, 2008 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Gala.

**Manager's Report:** Tom Mignano indicated that the Club has received rave reviews since reopening. He will be meeting on a regular basis with meeting planners to stress ease of using the facility. The Club recently received the Venue of the Year award 2005-2006 from the San Diego Meeting Planners Association. Our Conference and Catering crew of Dixie Lineberger and Natalie Svistoonoff have been a great team: Chef Ed, Temo and Omar have continued to wow the clientele with their expertise. The recently installed landscaping has made a big difference in the Club's appearance. More is yet to be completed. Tom thanked the Board and membership for his exciting 17<sup>th</sup> year at the new and improved Faculty Club at UCSD.

**Nominating Committee:** Wayne Kennedy reported on the results of the deliberations of the Nominating Committee. All five members whose terms are ending indicated their willingness to stand for election to another term of office. Thus, the slate of members standing for election is as is referenced on the enclosed ballot.

**New Business:** The Art Gallery is moving forward. The current showing has been extremely popular.
