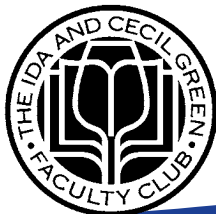

Highlights From the Annual Members' Meeting

On May 16, 2006, President Sally Ashburn called to order the Annual Members' Meeting. The meeting was well attended by Club members and many announcements were made. The highlights of meeting are as follows:

Finance: Ed Mayer distributed the Treasurer's report. He reported on the Club's financial outlook for the past year indicating we had an excellent year and are in a good position to support programs and upgrades during 2006. He commented that the Club has made its final contribution of \$322,500 to the campus Capital Campaign for the expansion of Club facilities which caused the anticipated reduction in reserves. The Club's relationship with Premier Food Services continues to be excellent.

House Committee: Tom Mignano reported that construction is on track. The Club will close on July 15 and reopen Sept. 12. The Dining Room Terrace will become part of the main dining room. The finishing touches to the Atkinson Pavilion and the Seuss Library along with the extended courtyard will be completed and ready for full use by mid-November. The Club staff is working with Housing and Dining Services and Campus Catering to direct meeting clients to alternative venues while the facility is closed.

Program Committee: Nolan Penn recapped the year's activities which included the traditional events such as the Bloomsday dinner, the various wine dinners and our Mother's Day brunch. Tom Mignano reported that several events are planned to ease the pain of our brief summer closure. Look for the "Summer Fun with the Club" article for more information.

Nominating Committee: Lynda Claassen reported on the results of the deliberations of the Nominating Committee. The slate of members standing for election is as follows: Barbara Baehr, Alain J. J. Cohen, Ed Mayer, Anne Middleton and Nolan Penn. President Ashburn asked for nominations from the floor. Hearing none, the slate will be presented to the members for a vote.

Comments from members were taken on adjustments and improvements to the new website. Due to the concerns of members, the Board of Directors has decided that we will only publicize events in the newsletter when the entire body of members is invited to attend.

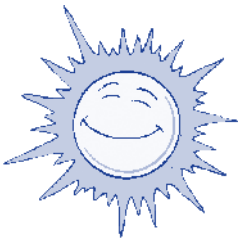
